Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 10/02/2014 , I am directed to inform you that the above mentioned complaint along with the report received from the concerned authorities were placed before the Commission on 30/09/2014 Upon pursuing the same, the Commission has directed as follows :-

*The Commission had received a complaint dated 10.02.2014 from one Hira Singh alleging that on 06.02.2014 when he was produced before Court in a case, the Investigating Officer had threatened him that the opponent will take revenge from the complainant and his wife. Next day he read in newspaper that his daughter Pooja was killed and his wife Vijaya sustained injuries due to bullet shots fired by named accused persons. The complainant vide his subsequent letter had alleged that his wife was raped and attempt was made to rape his daughter by one Baba and in order to hush up the matter, the accused had falsely implicated complainant in an abduction case. The FIR of rape was registered and the accused did not want that any statement be recorded against him, therefore he caused murder of complainant's daughter and injured his wife. The accused are having connections with higher authorities and the Police are acting in connivance with accused.*

*Another complaint dated 10.02.2014 from one Tara Singh (father-in-law of Hira Singh) was received in the same incident. The said complaint was registered as Case File No. 7968/24/52/2014. Henceforth, the consolidated proceedings shall be conducted for both these Case Files.*

*Superintendent of Police, Gramin/ Nodal Officer (HR), Mathura vide his communication dated 25.04.2014 submitted his report. Perusal of the same reveals that on 06.02.2014 Mrs. Vijaya Devi wife of Hira Singh (complainant) was going to Court with her daughter Pooja and accused fired bullet shots on them. Pooja died on the way to hospital and Vijaya sustained grievous injuries. The case Crime No. 31/2014 was registered at PS: Jamuna Paar, Mathura in the matter. During*

*investigation two accused were arrested, one surrendered in the Court and two other accused, including husband of Vijaya Devi, were in Jail in some other matter. It is stated that husband of Vijaya Devi wanted to settle some personal scores with other persons and in connivance with Vijiaya Devi, the incident had happened. Vijaya Devi was also accused in the incident and sent to Jail after arrest by Police. It is stated that investigation of matter is pending and would be concluded expeditiously.*

*Superintendent of Police, Gramin/ Nodal Officer (HR), Mathura vide his communication dated 31.07.2014 submitted his report. Perusal of the same reveals that after during investigation it was found that the incident was caused by the complainant himself, in order to take revenge with opponents. Smt. Vijaya was also accused in the incident and sent to Jail after arrest by Police. It is stated that investigation of matter was concluded and chare-sheet no. 54 dated 08.05.2014 was filed in the Court against the culprits who were found involved in offence as per investigation.*

*Let copies of the aforesaid reports be transmitted to the complainant for his comments, if any, within four weeks.*

Pursuant to the above directions, I am enclosing herewith a copy of the report for furnishing your comments, id any, by 10/11/2014 for consideration of the Commission.
